

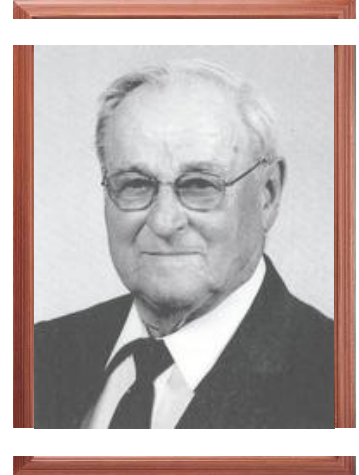
Joseph C. Schumacher

(June 11, 1917 - February 24, 2013)



Joseph C. Schumacher, age 95, of Wien, Missouri died Sunday, February 24, 2013 at Pioneer Skilled Nursing Center, Marceline.

Joe was born at Wien, Missouri on June 11, 1917 to Joseph J. and Frances (Meinhardt) Schumacher. Joe was a Veteran of the United States Army serving from 1945-1947 in the US Constabulary 6th Corp Headquarters CO. He worked for the US Postal Service in Kansas City retiring on December 31, 1972 and farmed part-time. He was a life member of the VFW # 1471, member of the American Legion # 264, both of Marceline, life member of D.A.V. Chapter 21 at Jefferson City, Marceline Eagles Lodge since 1973, Kansas City, Missouri Branch of Railway Mail Clerks and American Postal Workers Union for 60 years, and the St. Mary of the Angels Catholic Church in Wien. He was an avid hunter, conservationist, and gardener, and raised and bred horses in his retirement years. He was always out for a good time. He is survived by two sisters, Sylvia Dunning, Wien, MO and Florence Langenderfer, Cincinnati, OH; sixteen nieces, nephew and great nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, infant sister, brother Robert J. Schumacher, sister Kathryn Ricciardi, nephew Gary J. Schumacher, and special friend Charlene Frazier. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 AM Saturday, March 2, 2013 at the St. Mary of the Angels Catholic Church in Wien with Fr. William Korte and Fr. Jerry Kaimann officiating. Burial with Military Honors will be in the St. Mary's Cemetery, Wien.
